

COVID-19 NOTICE - IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ!

The Buckeye 600 Bowling Club and Ohio Women's 700 Club have the following recommended preventative measures in place to help reduce the spread of Covid-19 while in bowling centers. All board members & volunteers working the tournament will follow the same guidelines. Neither Club, nor the bowling center management can guarantee anyone will not become infected, you participate at your own risk.

1. All bowlers and spectators should perform a self-assessment prior to coming to the center. Stay home if you are feeling sick or unwell, or have been diagnosed Covid-19 positive.
2. Spectators will be strictly limited to one necessary person per tournament participant. Please be considerate of your friends & family as well as other participants - leave your extra friends & family home this year - bring only necessary individuals. All rules which apply to participants also apply to spectators.
3. Face coverings are required - no exceptions! Face coverings must always cover the nose, mouth and chin and must be worn the entire time you are in the center, with the exception of when you are up and ready to bowl or while you are seated at your table, actively eating or drinking. If you are unable to wear a face covering due to an underlying health issue, we urge you to consider joining us next year.
4. Practice Social Distancing - follow all directions in place while at the center and try to limit the amount of times you enter & exit the center.
5. A no-touch rule is in effect - all participants and spectators must refrain from physical contact of any type.
6. Congregating in any other area than your designated lane area is prohibited. When not bowling or moving through the center, you must remain in your designated lane area.
7. Wash / sanitize your hands as much as possible while inside the center.
8. Do not arrive to the center more than one hour before your squad time. You will not be permitted to go to your assigned lanes until ALL current bowlers have left that bowling area and the center has sanitized the area.
9. These safety measures may be altered at any time due to federal, state or local government health agencies' recommendations.
10. You voluntarily assume all associated risks which may result while participating in these tournaments.
